SUBJECT: INTRODUCTION OF ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS (SCIENCE) -REG.

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application No.-AS-00004-2526 dt. on the subject cited above.

In this connection, I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Introduction of additional subject(s). The school is required to follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed for All India Senior Secondary Examination of the Board and changes made therein:

Sl. No.	GENERAL CONDITIONS
1.	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 18 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2.	Compliance of the points no. 1 to 8 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.
Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 18 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school is not running bal-vatika presently. Thus, it is required to submit an undertaking that from upcoming session school will run bal-vatika within 03 months in the compliance.
3	All three science lab have curtain, which may pose as a fire hazard and they do not have seating arrangement for students. Further, biology lab is set-up on make-shift table without attached washbasin with water taps. Thus, the school is required to remove the curtain from all the labs, arrange the wooden stools for seating of students and re- setup the biology lab with permanent workstation with washbasin in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.

4	The school is required to set-up the composite science lab for secondary level in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	The computer lab has only 18 computers which are lesser than minimum requirement i.e. 40 computes. Thus, the school is required to procure more computers within 03 months and submit the invoice along with videography in the compliance.
6	The library is appearing to be under sized and it does not have sufficient seating arrangement for student and separate reading space for staff. Thus, the school is required to set-up the same in light of Board's SoP within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school has constructed CwSN toilets only on first floor, which are converted by regular cubicles, but they are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
8	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Delhi East within 03 months and submit the compliance.

The above is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions or as may be laid down by the Board from time to time:-

1. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students and renew all safety certificate as and when due.
3. The approval is subject to final outcome of any pending legal case/ litigation and any other issues arising out of it and Board shall not be responsible for any dispute/legal issue arising out .
4. The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

“The school shall possess valid Fire Safety certificate, Building safety certificate and Water and Sanitation Certificate alongwith other essential documents during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.
